Assisting our employees

Info related to materials / surfaces

It is strongly recommended that metal products are not handled without gloves, and are thoroughly cleaned with a disinfectant or alcohol solution. It has been documented, that COVID-19 may survive for up to 5 days on metal surfaces.

Material cleaning: Stainless steel: Alcohol solution 70% or greater Painted steel and anodized aluminum: detergent solution, rinsed with clean water

Other surfaces: Disinfectant spray or alcohol solution
